

Twin City Camera Club Descriptions of Select Subjects 2007 - 2008

General Rule (Applies to All)	The select subject must be prominently displayed and the PRIMARY focus of the image, so that an ordinary person would recognize it as such.

Month	Subject	Description
September	Shapes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Geometric shapes: triangles, circles, squares, pentagons, etc. Can include one or more of the same shape or multiple shapes.
October	One Tree	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only one Tree, if more than one Tree is visible it will be placed into the Open category.
November	Rocks, Stones or Pebbles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The object(s) that is the focus of attention in the image must be Rocks, stones or pebbles.
December	Repetitions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can be anything that is multiple(s) of the same thing.
January	Bridges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The object that is the focus of attention in the image must be the Bridge(s).
February	Night Shots	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be taken after sunset and before sunrise.
March	Frozen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The object that is the focus of attention in the image must be Frozen.
April	Silver/Chrome	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The object that is the focus of attention in the image must be predominantly Silver and/or Chrome.
May	Creepy Crawlers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bugs, not kids.
June	Nature	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The images must be naturally present in Nature. There can be no additions/deletions/distortions to the original image AFTER it is taken. (sharpening, etc is permitted). Must not contain any presence of the “hand of man”. In other words everything must be there naturally, without human intervention. It is your responsibility NOT to enter images where the “hand of man” has been removed after the image was taken, except for cropping. The image must not include wires, posts, lawns, construction, etc Unacceptable (examples): Cultivated or domestic plants, pets, farm animals, mounted specimens, leaves, sticks that are placed like props.
