Birds of Prey Photo Outing at the Outdoor Discovery Center in Holland, MI.

Despite heavy cloud cover and chilly temperatures, the photo shoot went well. Executive Director Travis Williams and Program Director Jamie Krupka of the Outdoor Discovery Center presented quite a few birds including a red-tailed hawk, a falcon, and several owls for our photographic pleasure. Photographers John Dykstra and Ed Post were also present to assist both the handlers and the photographers. Sixteen people from the Twin City Camera Club plus a few visitors were able to attend the late afternoon program. We had the opportunity to not only photograph the birds in a natural setting but also to view the birds and their behavior up close.
